- Sustainable Trailworks / Town of Stowe
 - \$10,000 trail maintenance budget
 - \$10k does not include SMBC allocations
 - Specific to trails on Town-owned land
 - Agreement renewed again for 2017

- Trail Maintenance Plan:
 - 2016, 2017 and beyond
 - Drafted in collaboration with Hardy Avery:
 - Long-term sustainability, not just seasonal repairs
 - Upgrades to:
 - Accommodate increased use
 - Incorporate modern trail building techniques where needed
 - Enhance with features as appropriate

- Long-range planning and budgeting
 - "Commercial level of use"
 - Florence

- 2016 Trail Maintenance Plan
 - Under budget for 2016
 - Town funds carry over (Zog's / Flo reroute)
 - 2016 Projects:
 - Bear's new berms, etc.
 - Schween's multiple reroutes
 - Sap Bucket culverts
 - Rock berm on lower
 - 8 Bridges new bridges

- 2017 Trail Maintenance Plan
 - Highlights:
 - Lower Florence: major rebuild
 - Zog's / Flo intersection reroute
 - Lauren's Loop: rebuild upper part
 - Pipeline collab with Trapp's trail crew
 - 8 Bridges: completion of rebuild

- Strategic Planning:
 - Five Year Trail Plan
 - Identified trail building opportunities

 - Approval / permitting process

 - Split Rock
 - Main Sterling network

- Topnotch to Sterling Valley via Catamount Trail
 - Collaborative effort between SMBC & CTA
 - Next steps: secure permission for fourseason use
 - Build Adams Camp Connector on West side of Mountain Road

- 2017 and Beyond:
 - Eagle Ridge at Cady Hill Forest
 - Cotton Brook / connection to Little River
 State Park

Strawberry Hill Farm

- New ownership:
 - These trails open and close in conjunction with CHF
 - Use remains very much a privilege and not a right
 - Maintenance needs


