Edson Hill Connector	<ul> <li>Reviewed proposed map</li> <li>Discussed landowners, who we've talked to</li> <li>Rachel to continue working with Catamount trail (Matt) on landowner relations</li> </ul>
B3 Discussion	<ul> <li>Group (Leslie, Rachel, Lucy and others) met to discuss B3</li> <li>Morgan, Ed, and STP agreed that B3 does not have a sole contact/project manager</li> <li>Has been shrinking because of that</li> <li>Option 1 - Provide presentation to why SAA should take over B3.
